

**CARROLL COUNTY, IOWA
ORDINANCE NO. 38**

AN ORDINANCE of the County of Carroll, Iowa, providing for participation in educational material distribution.

WHEREAS Iowa Code Chapter 23A provides for noncompetition by government with private business, the Board of Supervisors finds that certain activities should be allowed including the distribution of educational materials by county employees.

Section 1 The Ordinances of the County of Carroll, Iowa, are amended by adopting this Ordinance:
County employees are authorized to distribute educational materials provided by private firms.

Section 2. **REPEALER.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. **SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. **WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
